05/09/2011 - Behind the scenes of artificial breast manufacturing



According to sources, there is a real difference in quality of products on the current breast implant market. Thus it is essential to be informed of the type of implants used at the time of your surgery because implants have been found originating from China or Eastern countries, which have not necessarily been subjected to the same inspections as in certain laboratories.

Preparation of implants in the Sebbin Laboratories is carried out professionally, using state-of-the-art technology. A process of creation with quality and safety as the key words. It should be kept in mind that an implant is going to be present in the human body for a minimum duration of ten years, thus it is essential that it conforms to precise specifications at the design stage. In this French laboratory built close to Paris the implants are crafted and inspected manually. 100% of implants are inspected individually at key stages in the manufacturing process. All the implants undergo around 10 tests. The raw materials are certified by the highest medical authorities.



The choice of raw material and its quality are essential. Silicone is used for breast implants. Silicone can exist in the form of an oil, resin, rubber or also a gel. The gel present in implants may vary in quality, and must above all be highly resistant to impact. An implant is comprised of a flexible sheath made from silicone rubber. The quality of the latter is critical, as it is in direct contact with the body. The sheath is sealed with a plug and is then filled with cohesive silicone gel. Sometimes the sheath is sold empty and the surgeon fills it with physiological serum. For the past 25 years, thanks to thorough quality control inspections, Sebbin Laboratories has been offering a large range of implants for both aesthetic and reconstructive surgery. Nowadays, Sebbin Laboratories can provide a virtually customised service to women thanks to a very broad collection of breast implants of multiple sizes but also differing in firmness, facilitating a more "natural" effect.
